FULL DAY WORKSHOP Intermediate

Join Belinda Richards as she takes you through her creative process from conception to finished masterpiece.

We will start by learning about Belinda's creative thought process and how it has developed over the years. Discussing from initial idea to full realisation you will be taken through the creative journey and how it is the dogs themselves that inspire and provoke the art.

Moving on to the studio Belinda will show you how she captures and lights her subjects and show you the tricks she uses to capture the expressions that form the basis of her composites. We will also be shooting the supporting elements of the image demonstrating the lighting techniques she uses to ensure a consistent result.

Finally we will sit down while Belinda teaches you how she composites her subject and the elements together using a bit of photoshop magic to create the final vision. She will share her favourite photoshop tips and tricks and editing practices.

This will be a hands on Masterclass with all files shot provided to students so they can complete the final piece. As students will not finish during class time images can be submitted to Belinda for critique after the class through a private Facebook group.

Her clients already know when they book that this is not going to be a cheap experience. She positions herself as a luxury boutique brand with a fun twist and attracts her ideal client almost every time.

During this masterclass Belinda will take you through the exact journey her clients go through from how they are attracted to make that initial inquiry to after the artwork is hanging on the wall at home. She will share programs and processes and language she uses throughout her three-appointment process that sees her average client spend exceeding \$3000.

Belinda started her photographic journey in 2010 at the age of 30 by heading back to school. Completing her Diploma of Photo Imaging (Photographic Imaging College) and then her Bachelor of Arts (Fine Art) (with Distinctions Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology) 5 years later. Upon completion, like a significant percentage of art students, she went and got a "real job".

The majority of Belinda's working life has been with animals. Starting an awarding winning pet grooming business straight out of home was just the start. Throughout her studies and upon completion Belinda worked in animal welfare for various local councils and organisations.

The decision to begin Frog Dog Studios in mid 2016 came out of love for animals, a passion to create art and fatigue of the animal welfare industry. February 2017 saw the doors of Frog Dog Studios open in Yarraville Victoria. By July she had quit her "real job" to work in her dream business full time. A logical step for a business owner who has spent her entire working life with animals and studying fine art photography.

Since then Belinda has continued to develop her photographic skills winning numerous awards across multiple international competitions including the 2019 AIPP Australian Pet/Animal Photographer of the Year ,2019 Epson AIPP Victorian Pet/Animal Photographer of the Year and most unexpectedly the Nikon NZIPP International Photographer of the Year.

Belinda's love of the craft see's her handing every step of the creative process from capture to print ensuring each step is executed expertly to perfection. This coupled with her history of working with animals sees her intuitively capture her subjects like no other, creating fine art portraits that communicate, connect and emote.

Belinda currently lives in Yarraville, Victoria and continues to run Frog Dog Studios with her husband, two rescue dogs and rescue cat.
